  - Josh McGuire emphasized need for more youth involvement.

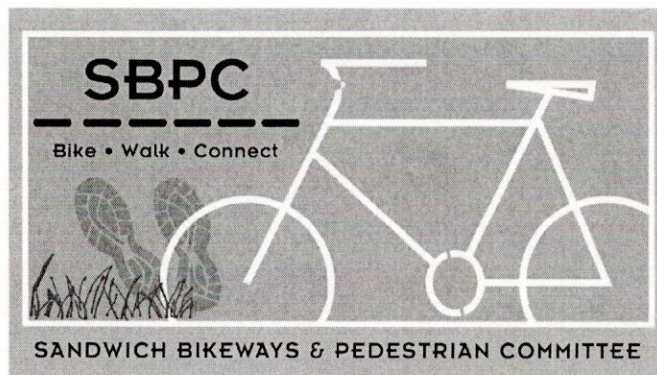
