Meeting called to order: 6:33 p.m. with Lee Rindfuss serving as chair.

Minutes

- Minutes for Jan. 24 were unanimously approved with one abstention (Polay)..
- Minutes for March 28 were approved unanimously.

Route 6A Paving

- Discussed how we can get better informed about state paving projects, and provide input for cycling and pedestrian improvements.

Boardwalk

- Question was raised about whether we should add our voice to discussion about the boardwalk
- Consensus was committee was not prepared to vote on an endorsement at that particular meeting, but moving forward we should weigh in on plans for the Boardwalk. It's an important node in town, especially as a connection between Jarvesville and Town Neck. Our pending master plan treats it as an important connector and destination.

Route 6A / Merchant Square Crossing

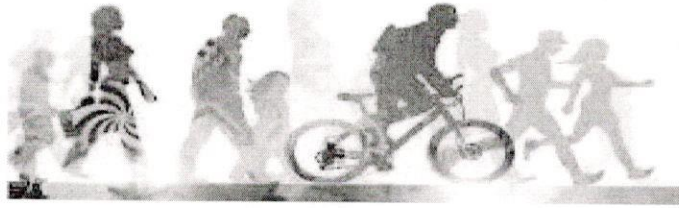
- Jensen provided a general update on correspondence between town and state so far. MassDOT has been evaluating safety at that location. Polay volunteered to become more involved. Jensen will follow-up.

Master Plan

- Town had substantive comments about concepts in draft alternatives -- for example: speed zone changes that should be addressed in a way that is consistent with Town of Sandwich. Toole Design Group will update their items, and come to the next meeting.

Bike Rodeo
