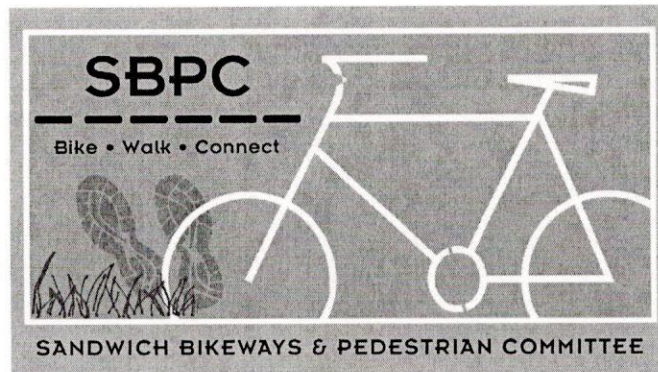
MASTER PLAN
