1. The meeting was brought to order by Sandra Tompkins at 7:00 p.m.

2. Tobacco Regulation Violations

On April 27, 2017, a tobacco regulation violation occurred at Quaker Meetinghouse Package Store located at 263 Cotuit Road. Representing Quaker Meetinghouse Package Store was store Owner, Dennis Konary. Mr. Konary informed the board that he reviewed the tobacco policy with all of his employees and suspended the employee responsible. Mr. Konary paid the \$200.00 fine for the second violation within a year. The board suspended Quaker Meetinghouse Package Store tobacco license for (7) seven days from June 13th – June 20th, 2017.

Also, on April 27, 2017, Speedway #2427 located at 273 Cotuit Road & the Speedway #2444 located at 336 Route 130 violated the tobacco regulation. Present to represent Speedway was the district manager, Oneil Taylor. He informed the board that the employees responsible for the violations were terminated from employment with the company. Mr. Taylor paid \$100 fine for each location. Mr. Mason told the board that this was Speedways first violation.

3. Hearing for proposed the Board of Health Alternative Septic System Tracking Regulation

David Mason presented the proposed regulation to track Alternative Septic Systems through Barnstable County. The regulation states any person or entity that owns, operates, inspects or monitors an alternative onsite septic system in the Town of Sandwich shall provide the results of all monitoring and inspections to the Board of Health, or an entity designated by the Board of Health, in a format designated by the Health Agent. All reports regarding maintenance, monitoring or inspections of alternative septic systems shall be submitted within thirty (30) days of the time when the maintenance, inspection or monitoring was initiated. Sandra Tompkins made a motion to approve the regulation, seconded by Rebecca Scott, and the motion passed with a vote of 3-0-0 with an effective date of July 1, 2017.



4. Reserved for topics not anticipated by the Chairperson

David Mason provided the board with information regarding Eversource Energy Yearly Operational Plan for Cape Cod & Martha's Vineyard for the use of herbicides on Rights-of-Way list. Mr. Mason re-affirmed the Board's stand opposing the use of herbicides on the Eversource Right of Way and only mechanical clearing has occurred in Sandwich.

Also presented was a yearly report from the Massachusetts Department of Public Health regarding the reported Cancer Incidences from 2009-2013 with different types of programs now available and case changes through the years.

Sandra Tompkins asked to reconfigure the Board. The Board is required to reconfigure after the election. No members volunteered to be the Chairwoman. Rebecca Scott recommended Sandra Tompkins as Chairwoman, seconded by Pamela Snyder and passed with a vote of 3-0-0.

5. Review/Approval of Minutes

A motion was made by Rebecca Scott to approve the minutes of the Board of Health Meeting from April 10, 2017 as written, seconded by Dana Snyder, and the motion passed with a vote of 3-0-0.

Sandra Tompkins asked to reconfigure the Board. The Board is required to reconfigure after the election. No members volunteered to be the Chairwoman. Rebecca Scott recommended Sandra Tompkins as Chairwoman, seconded by Pamela Snyder and passed with a vote of 3-0-0.

A motion was made by Rebecca Scott to adjourn the meeting at 7:33 and was seconded by Pamela Snyder
