Article ____ – To see if the Town will vote to amend the Sandwich Protective Zoning By-laws, Section 2300, Use Regulation Schedule, by deleting the use item “Municipal sewage treatment with onsite disposal of secondary-treated effluent” and inserting in its place use items “Wastewater Treatment Facility” and “Wastewater Effluent Disposal” as written below:

DEFINITIONS

WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY – A public or private facility constructed to treat wastewater, not including the disposal of treated effluent.

WASTEWATER EFFLUENT DISPOSAL – The disposal of treated effluent from a public or private wastewater treatment facility.
