Minutes of a public meeting held on **July 21, 2014**, by the **Sandwich Board of Health** in the Town Office Building Meeting Room, 16 Jan Sebastian Drive, Sandwich, MA.

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The meeting was brought to order by Sandra Tompkins at 7:04pm.

1. New Bedford Waste Services, Sandwich Division, 295 Service Road

In attendance for an informal discussion of the proposed temporary structure was Peter Flood of Green Seal Environmental, vice president/general manager, Michael Camara of New Bedford Waste Services, and Business Supervisor, Scott Graves of New Bedford Waste Services. Peter Flood presented plans for a temporary structure to resume waste management on a limited level. The temporary tent like structure would be 65'x100' sitting upon 2'x2'x4' concrete blocks. Sandra Thompkins expressed concerns about flooding during the excessive rain. Peter Flood suggested the use of a temporary berm to be put into place. A large block wall would be constructed along the back to reduce any noise. The hours of operation would be from 8:00a.m.-5:00p.m., Monday –Friday. Inbound tonnage would be limited to 200 tons per day which would be emptied by the end of each business day. The structure would not have a sprinkler system. Any loads containing hazardous waste and asbestos would be rejected. Universal waste (computer, TV's, etc.) would be inspected and removed to a recycling site. The estimated time frame for a rebuild is approximately 9 month after approvals.

The proposed new permanent building would be insulated for noise reduction and include a sprinkler system. Health Agent, David Mason made mention of the settlement agreement with New Bedford Waste Services, item #18B , setting aside \$6,000.00 for the Board of Health for testing. David Mason requested a signed statement by the new owner in reference to the settlement agreement along with an informal site plan review before construction.

2. New Business

The Board welcomed the new administrative assistant, Jennifer Woodbury to the Health Department.

David Mason informed the Board that NStar is spraying for pesticides and is allowed to do so by the court.



3. Old Business


