Minutes of a public meeting held on **June 13, 2022**, by the **Sandwich Board of Health** in the Human Services Building Meeting Room, 270 Quaker Meetinghouse Road, Sandwich, MA.

1. The meeting was brought to order by Rebecca Lovell Scott at 7:00 p.m.

The Chair, Rebecca Lovell Scott opened the meeting and informed everyone in attendance that the Meeting was not advertised as a public forum and is not open for public comments. David Mason explained the authority of the Board of Health and the legal process to adopt a regulation for the July 11th Board of Health Meeting.

2. Fowl Regulations: Review draft regulations. Vote to move the regulation to a public meeting.

David Mason explained that he made the requested changes from the Board to the proposed regulation and supplied a copy to the Board, and everyone in attendance for tonight's meeting. The Board reviewed the regulation for any further changes. No further changes were discussed. David Liskowski made a motion to present the proposed regulation to public meeting for a vote at the July 11th Board of Health meeting, seconded by Rebecca Lovell Scott. The motion passed with a vote of 2-0-0.

(Board Member Ron Hurley joined the meeting 7:10 p.m.)

3. Animal Inspector appointment. Walter Fagnant

Mr. Mason explained to the Board that the Health Department would like the Board to appoint Animal Control Officer, Walter Fagnant the Inspector of Animals. Mr. Fagnant handles animal complaints, as well as dog bites. This will give him authority to issue the quarantine while on site. Rebecca Lovell Scott made a motion to appoint Walter Fagnant the Inspector of Animals, seconded by David Liskowski. The motion passed with a vote of 3-0-0.

4. Pond Testing Update

David Mason updated the Board that the he will begin pond testing of all ponds with public town access. Cyanobacteria testing will not be occurring. The lifeguards will be trained to identify when blooms occur and what action to taken to post an advisory. David presented the Board with new signage for posting at the ponds for an algae bloom advisory.


6. Approval of Minutes from May 9, 2022
