**Adventure Playground:** J. O'Brien and sons has not submitted proposals or responded. Three other companies plan to send schematics and estimates. Resource for grants: Sandwich Women's Club; Letter of Intent \$250,000 ARPA grant funds. Hoping for CPA funds, too. Guy and Assistant Town Manager, Heather Harper working on this.

**Summer Programs:** Fabulous! Smoothly run with less staff. Forced to eliminate guards at some beaches. Ran Jr. Life Guard Program hoping students will return next year. Exit interviews indicated the majority of staff is returning. Exit evaluations: some suggestions and lots of praise for all: Adult Soccer; Super Fun Program and Week Long Programs (Level I and II, Ninja, Swim Lessons, BMX, Rocking Rockets, Kayaking, Sandwich Tiny Tykes, Tennis, Film Making, Kids Test Kitchen, Soccer, Swim level 4, Mini Kickers Soccer, Skateboarding, Challenger Sports Soccer Camp, Cooking, Youth Tennis USTA grades 6-8, Level 2 swimming, Paddle board, Grade 1 Tennis, Sailing)  
Gate attendants good. Part time Hoxie House and Grist Mill less revenue. Parking funds lower this year than last. Largest revenues from First Beach and Tree House Brewery parking. Overall fund shortage


No Fall Fest this year. Lack of funds.

**4<sup>th</sup> of July review:** suggestions: Check vehicles prior to parade for anything that shouldn't be displayed, Hang t-shirts and display prices. Was fundraiser for Little League at snack bar successful?  
Summary: parade went well. Field Activities were enjoyed by all. DJ was fabulous. Moonlighters and Fire Works were Awesome!  
Issue: Fireworks can no longer be shot of from graveyard due to tree canopy cover and soft road. Price is less than \$10,000 – no bidding. Where to have them in the future? Not at high school due to turf. Not at Wing – residential.  
Possibilities: shoot from barge on Peter's Pond or PA Landers but where does band go? What to do about boat parade?

**Parks and Facilities:** Concerns that tennis and pickle all do not have enough open court time. Need Liaison to unlock and lock gates. No budget for this and no volunteers. Courts need to be locked due to Skate Park. Pickle Ball has a FB group. Reservations for courts seem to work well.  
Other towns have different open court play times.  
Rec. Com recommends an open meeting with the pickle ball group to determine workable solution. Can't paint tennis courts with pickle ball lines. SCAL- indoor pickle ball courts.  
Landscaping being completed to unify Skate Park, courts, SCAL and police and fire. SCAL may open First of Year.  
**Disc Golf:** continuous clearing. Added more tee pads. Upcoming tournaments
