SANDWICH TODAY

- Sandwich has approx. 10,000 units of housing, 71% are owner-occupied, 7% are rentals, 17% are seasonal and 5% undefined¹
- Roughly 314 homes are deed restricted affordable²
- Average household size 2.57³
- 87.5% of Sandwich residents drive alone on their commute to work. The mean commuter travel time is 29.8 minutes one-way⁴

Frequently Asked Questions

- **Why should I attend these workshops?**
Your participation will help us frame and create a 10-year plan that will guide future decision-making in town.
- **What will be asked of me at the workshop?**
At the workshop you will be split into groups of 4-6 people. We will ask you a series of questions related to the workshop topic.
- **I noticed there are different workshops. Should I attend all of them?**
There are 5 topics, identified in a community visioning survey, that we are asking for input on. We are holding two workshops on each topic to gather maximum participation.
- **What will be done with the findings of the workshops?**
We will use the findings as a baseline to create action items that will guide decision making over the next 10-years.
