SANDWICH TODAY

- Sandwich has over 4,135 acres of open land. 2,200 acres of these lands were acquired for conservation purposes¹
- There is roughly 18 miles of walking/hiking trails within existing conservation land²
- Public recreational space amenities include Sandwich Hollows Golf Club, Quaker Meetinghouse Rd. Skate Park and Pickle Ball Courts, Oak Crest Cove Disc Golf Course and ball fields, tennis courts and swimming pool located throughout the Town's four schools³

Frequently Asked Questions

- **Why should I attend these workshops?**
Your participation will help us frame and create a 10-year plan that will guide future decision-making in town.
- **What will be asked of me at the workshop?**
At the workshop you will be split into groups of 4-6 people. We will ask you a series of questions related to the workshop topic.
- **I noticed there are different workshops. Should I attend all of them?**
There are 5 topics, identified in a community visioning survey, that we are asking for input on. We are holding two workshops on each topic to gather maximum participation.
- **What will be done with the findings of the workshops?**
We will use the findings as a baseline to create action items that will guide decision making over the next 10-years.
