- Demographics: White 95%, African American 1%, Native 0.3%, Asian 1.6%, Hispanic or Latino 2.1% ¹(U.S Census)
- Sandwich has acquired 2,200 acres of open land for conservation purposes²
- Sandwich is comprised of 4 distinct areas; Forestdale, South Sandwich, East Sandwich and the Village. Each area has their own unique features
- Sandwich was the first town to be established on Cape Cod and is home to a large Regional Historic District as well as three National Register Districts

Frequently Asked Questions

- **Why should I attend these workshops?**
Your participation will help us frame and create a 10-year plan that will guide future decision-making in town.
- **What will be asked of me at the workshop?**
At the workshop you will be split into groups of 4-6 people. We will ask you a series of questions related to the workshop topic.
- **I noticed there are different workshops. Should I attend all of them?**
There are 5 topics, identified in a community visioning survey, that we are asking for input on. We are holding two workshops on each topic to gather maximum participation.
- **What will be done with the findings of the workshops?**
We will use the findings as a baseline to create action items that will guide decision making over the next 10-years.
